Action Items/Notes:

1. DMNS is a deferred maintenance project – no match but is shovel ready, can be scaled based on criticality, and could be an early win as is shovel ready.
2. DBG originally submitted 3 projects, now advancing only one – the Voght Event Center – a permanent structure - will increase ability to host events throughout the year, regardless of weather.
3. DAM also a deferred maintenance project, roof replacement and accessible doors throughout the buildings.
4. DZCA Latin America exhibit proposal – large project but would be an economic driver for the city – no other city has, is scalable and does have matching funds.
5. CSO Boettcher Concert Hall – has already been scaled, large project, they are planning a fundraising campaign.
6. DCPA Bonfils Lobby project, “living room” of the theatre complex, safety concerns addressed.
