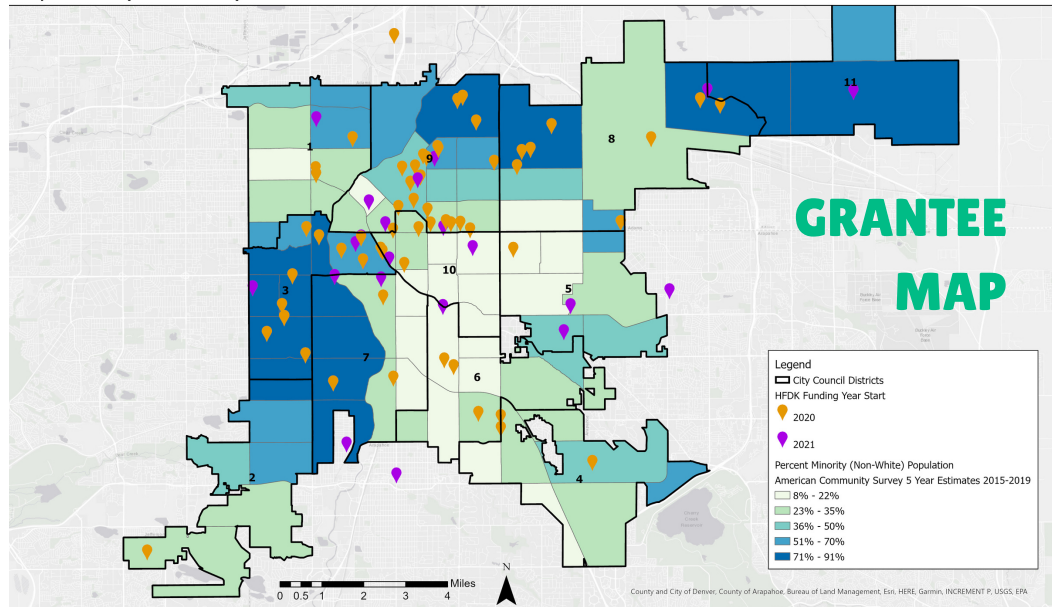

TYPES OF PROGRAMS FUNDED

High school food pantries

Youth food leadership development and internships
