

Fine Schedule for Residential Health, Pools, Lead, Child Care, Body Art, Cannabis Businesses*, Regulated Venues where Sexual Encounters Occur**, and Settings where Public Health Orders are in Effect

Enforcement tools used by the Division of Public Health Investigations under Chapter 24, D.R.M.C. include civil penalties, court summons, retention of equipment, closure of businesses, placards, and orders to address public health hazards. The level of enforcement may vary depending on the nature of the violation, the duration of non-compliance, the history of non-compliance, the number of rule violations, and other applicable factors.
